

DOG CONTROL

The SPCA has been providing services to the Town of Lysander for over 4 years, and in that time they have attended hundreds of calls ranging from barking complaints to vicious dog attacks.

The SPCA enforces:

Local Law #1 - Dogs running at large: This means any dog that is not on a leash or not contained to the owner's property by a fence physical or electronic. It is presumed per the local ordinance that the owner knows about their dog's lack of leash or containment and said owner may suffer some consequence for allowing this violation to occur.

Local Law #2- Barking Dogs: If a dog is barking longer than 10 minutes continuously or 30 minutes intermittently in a one-hour period, that is a violation of local law/ordinance, and the dog owner may suffer consequences.

NYS Law and/or Local Law #3- Licensing: A dog must be licensed when it turns 4 months old, and proof of rabies is required. It does not matter if it never goes outside, or if it is a friendly dog, or if it does not like to wear a collar. A good dog owner usually does what is best for their dog, and the very best thing you can do for your dog is to get it licensed.
