DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS

Your primary work will be involved in regular maintenance crew work. This work includes such tasks as flagging, mowing, road work and doing other heavy physical labor activities. You can be expected to operate equipment, such as lawn mowers, weed whackers, chain saws and other small equipment. During the winter, everyone performs snow and ice control activities, such as the wing plow in a two-person plowing operation. Winter snow and ice control activities will involve a shift in your normal work hours including call-in overtime.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES

Laborers perform a wide variety of routine manual activities under supervision, but not limited to: Ditch cleaning, mowing, brush and tree removal, flagging for traffic control, salters, snow blowing, shoveling, assist with equipment repair and maintenance of equipment. In addition of the use of simple hand tools, chain saws, power mowers and like equipment, a laborer may operate such equipment portable electric generators, compressors, salt spreader, pumps and other non-self- propelled machines. They may occasionally operate self-propelled equipment such as trucks, riding lawn mowers and other light equipment.
