NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Lysander,

1. That the Supervisor is authorized to act on behalf of the Town
Board of the Town of Lysander in all matters related to State assistance
under ECL Articles 17, 51 and 56 and/or any applicable federal grant provisions. The
Supervisor is also authorized to make application, execute the State Assistance Contract,

- submit Project documentation, and otherwise act for the Town Board in all matters related to the Project and to State assistance;
- 2. That the Town agrees that it will fund its portion of the cost of the Project and that funds will be available to initiate the Project's field work within twelve (12) months of written approval of its application by the Department of Environmental Conservation;
- 3. That one (1) certified copy of this Resolution be prepared and sent to the Albany office of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation.
- 4. That this Resolution takes effect immediately.
