Town of Lysander

Local Law Number 2 of the year 2018.

A local law amending Chapter 129 entitled "Vehicle and Traffic" of the Town of Lysander.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Lysander ("Town Board") as follows:

Section One (1). PURPOSE AND INTENT.

This Local Law provides for an amendment to Chapter 129 entitled "Vehicle and Traffic Law" relative to parking regulations on the following streets: Oak Brook Road, Twin Flowers Road, Van Wie Drive West, Alletta Circle, Corlear Drive, Van Wie Drive East, Madeleine Drive, Briar Patch, Reston Drive, Grey Birch, Stanford Drive, and Marinus Drive.

The Town Board accordingly desires to amend Section 129, specifically Article III, Sections 44 of the Town of Lysander Code, to adopt and approve the same pursuant to its authority to rule or regulate the same under (NYS) Vehicle and Traffic Law Section 1682 and/or under its Home Rule Authority.

Section Two (2).

Article III, Section 44 is hereby amended to read:

Parking shall be prohibited on the Friday and Saturday immediately preceding Mothers' Day each year from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM on the side of the street as posted, on the following streets: Oak Brook Road, Twin Flowers Road, Van Wie Drive, Alletta Circle, Corlear Drive, Van Wie Drive East, Madeleine Drive, Briar Patch, Reston Drive, Grey Birch, Stanford Drive, and Marinus Drive.

Section Three (3). SEVERABILITY. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity or circumstances is adjudged invalid, illegal or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such order or judgment shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this law or in its application directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this Local Law or the application thereof to other persons or circumstances. Further, in adjudging such invalid, illegal or unconstitutional provision, the court shall attempt to modify same to a provision which is not invalid, illegal or unconstitutional and which best achieves the intent of the invalid provision.

Section Four (4). EFFECTIVE DATE. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing in the office of the Secretary of State.
